

What is the **BBMRI.se** Sample Collection Register?

The BBMRI.se Sample Collection Register is a freely available web application for data administration and discovery of sample collections of human origin such as blood, serum, plasma and tissue.

The register lists over 80 sample collections from more than one million donors associated with diagnoses such as neoplasms, diseases of the nervous system and diseases of the circulatory system.
